FROM THE NORTH AND EAST (M65):

From the **M65** get off at **junction 8**, take the **A56 south** for 4 miles until you reach the roundabout. Turn **left** onto the A680 into Haslingden (1 mile). In a short while you will see a church high on the hill on your left and the road will bend around it. When you get to the **mini-roundabout** turn **left**, pass the Coop store and at the top turn right into Regent Street. Continue past the top of cobbled Deardengate and go straight down Bury Road. Pass the Baptist Church on your left, and **The Spring** is farther along on your left by the letterbox. There is a carpark at the Community Link beyond St Mary's Catholic Church.

FROM THE WEST (M6):

A scenic approach is to continue on the M6 until you reach the **M65** (via M61 from the north). Travel east on the M65 to **junction 5** then turn right onto the **A6177**, signed to Haslingden and Darwen which goes through **Grane** (6 miles). After that you go under the A56 by-pass, and up a steep hill. At the very **top** turn **left** into a **one-way** street called Deardengate. Go straight over the traffic lights and up the cobbled part of Deardengate. At the top by the big lamp turn right into Bury Road. Pass the Baptist Church on your left, and The Spring is farther along on your left by the letterbox. There is a carpark at the Community Link beyond St Mary's Catholic Church.

FROM THE SOUTH (M66):

Take the **M66** north (from Manchester or from M60/M62) to the end. Ignore a blue motorway sign for the A56; the M66 becomes the A56 after entering Lancashire. Take the **A56** left fork towards Accrington (not the A681) and immediately take the next turn onto the **A680** signed to Haslingden. At the first roundabout turn **right** and at the next go **straight over**, into Haslingden. After the Bender factory on your left and a petrol station on your right, take the right fork into Bury Road. Go past Poplar Street on your right and there will be a carpark at the Community Link. The Spring is farther along Bury Road past St Mary's Catholic Church.

BY BUS:

Manchester's Chorlton Street coach station is about a 5 minute walk from Piccadilly railway station. Right outside Chorlton Street coach station take the X40 or X41 or X42 bus direct to **Haslingden via the M66**. Stay on the bus until it reaches the centre of Haslingden. Get off at the Methodist Church in Manchester Road and walk up Beaconsfield Street or Park Street and cross Bury Road at the zebra-crossing by the letterbox outside The Spring.

BY TRAIN:

Alternatively take a train from Preston or Leeds to **Accrington**, walk along Blackburn Road to the bus station. Pick up a **464** bus to Haslingden get off at the Dale Street stop. Walk up Beaconsfield Street or Park Street, and cross the zebra crossing to the letterbox outside **The Spring**.
